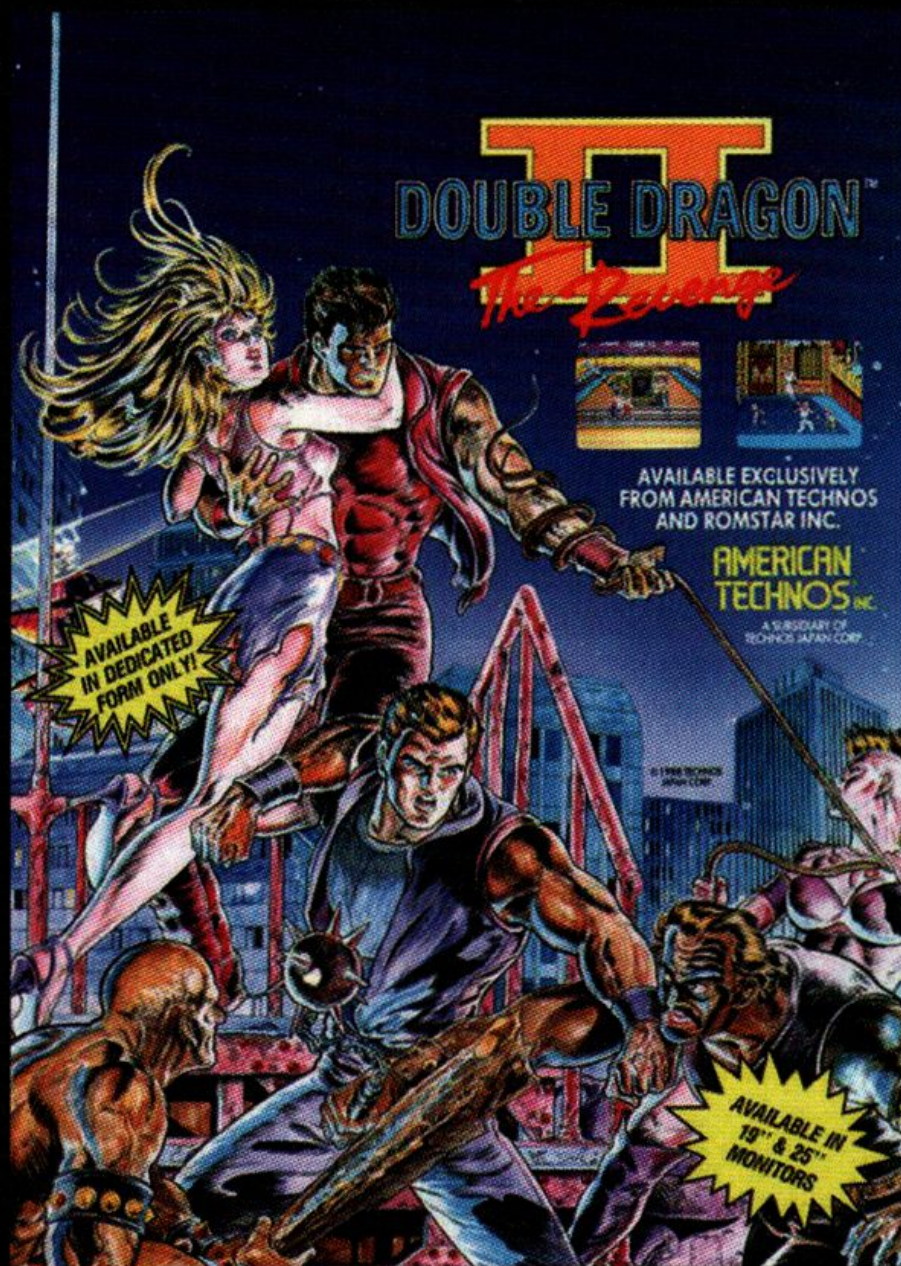
Initially, Technōs had to work alongside other companies to get their games published, but they hit the big-time with their long-running range of “Kunio-kun” games — and, of course, their legendary series of belt-scrolling beat ‘em ups in the Double Dragon series.

Technōs left the scene in 1996, but they left an incredible legacy behind, consisting of both genre-defining and highly creative games.
