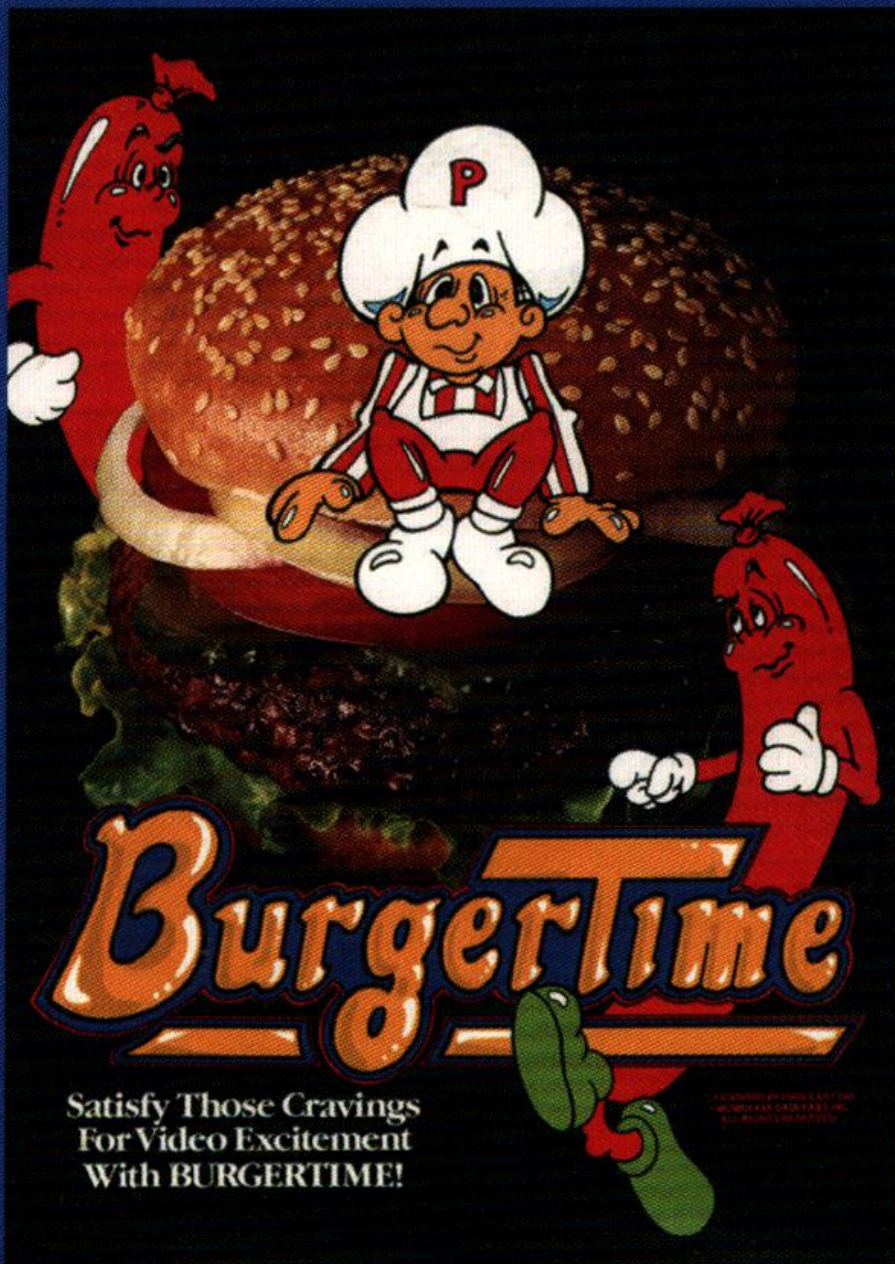
Data East became known for its varied lineup of games, which ran the gamut from frantic maze chases to bone-crunching brawlers — with plenty of creative takes on classic genres.
