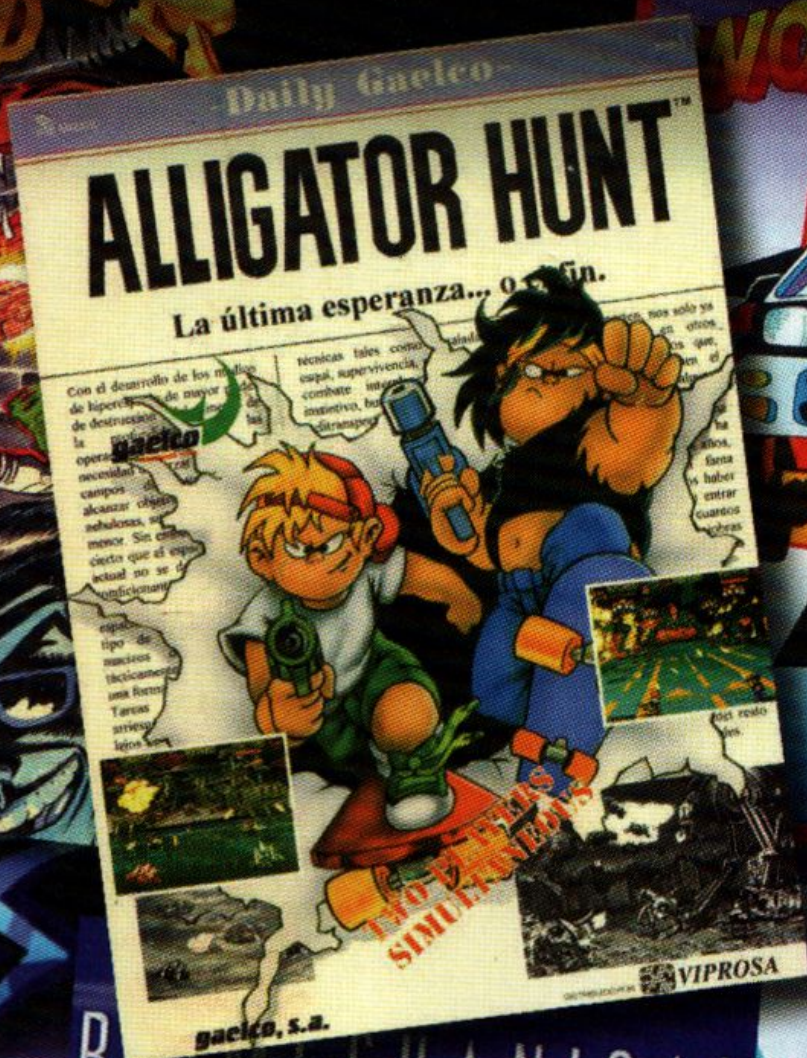

Gaelco is a Spanish company that was established in 1985. While best known for their electronic darts machines today, throughout the 1990s they were renowned for their lineup of technically proficient and stylish arcade games — many of which feature digitised guitar playing by their in-house musician Joan Sanmarti Serra.

Although European in origin, many of Gaelco's games draw strong influences from Japanese popular media. Notable examples include platformer Thunder Hoop, which has an aesthetic reminiscent of Akira Toriyama's work, and Glass, where... well, we'll leave that for you to discover.

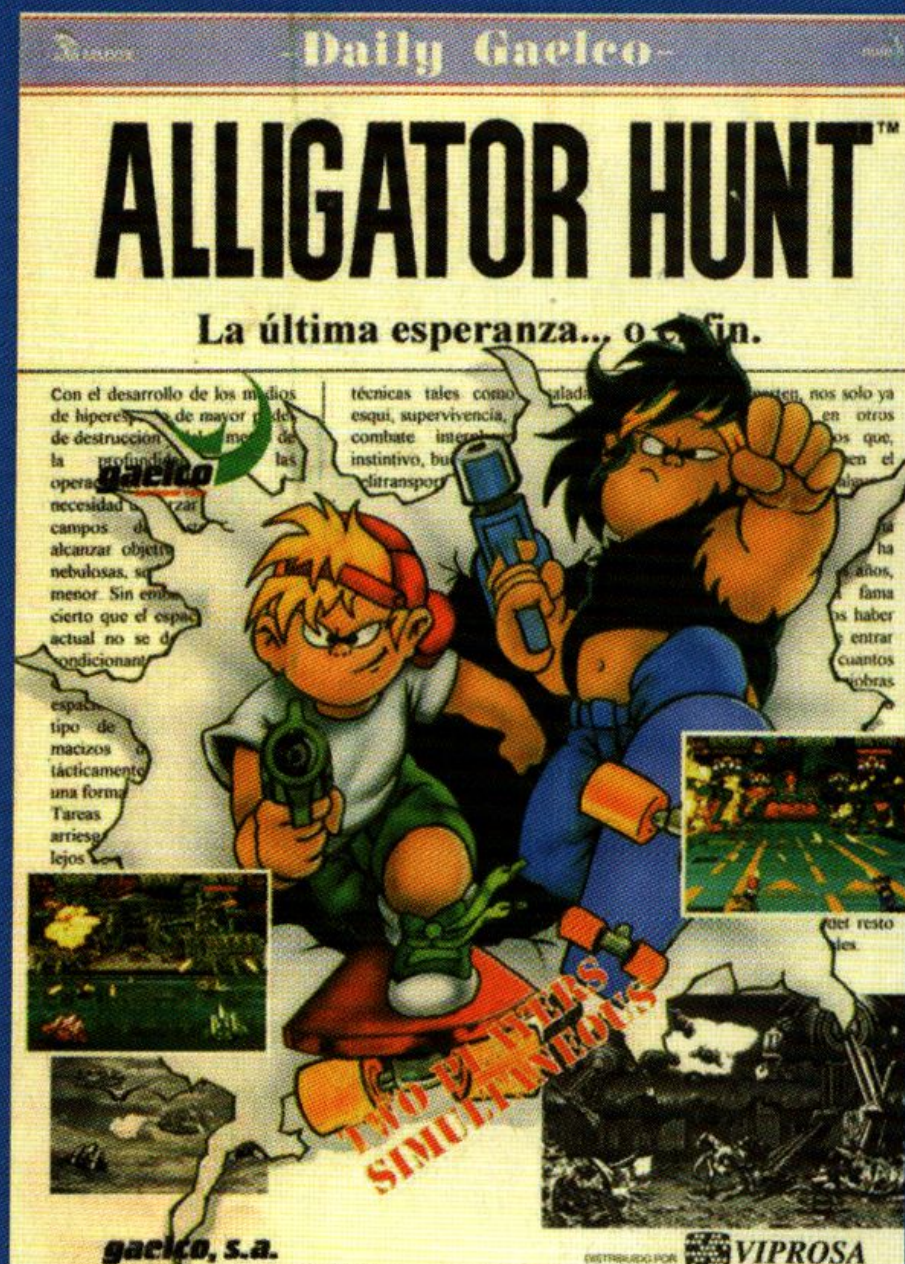

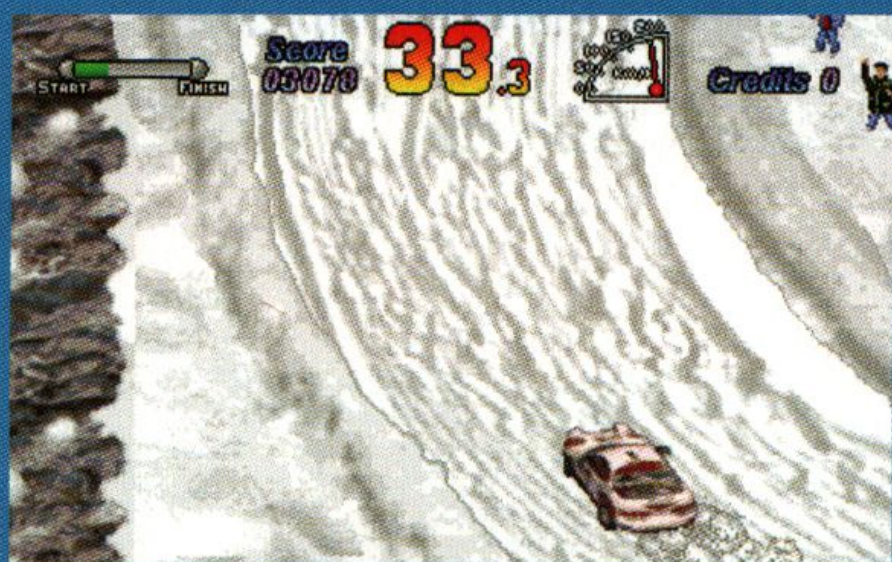
World Rally was originally supposed to feature the likeness of a famous rally driver, but he changed teams during development.
