Songbird Productions' founder Carl Forhan was always an Atari fan in the making. He grew up with the Atari 2600 console and fondly remembered games of that era such as Asteroids and Pitfall, but in the early 1990's time away at college and a new job meant he had all but left gaming behind. Then, with the growing popularity of the information superhighway and a little thing called "Usenet," he discovered a passionate set of Atari fans. A handful had even figured out how to hack then-current Atari gaming systems, namely the Atari Lynx. Soon thereafter he received a homemade cable and custom cartridge that allowed him to download games to Lynx RAM, and he was hooked.


In 1999 he published his very first independent Lynx and Jaguar games, and Songbird Productions was born.

About the Atari®Lynx

1989 was a big year. The world was changing, and the portable gaming revolution was about to begin. Along with some other more famous consoles, the Atari® Lynx was introduced and unlike its competitors it offered a full colour backlit display with 16-bit graphics and a wider screen ratio than other systems.

The Lynx was originally developed by gaming publisher Epyx, first called the Handy. Epyx approached Atari who had no handheld system of their own to help market and distribute the product. Atari finished the development and launched in 1989 with an emphasis on arcade conversions of hit games.

As with many ambitious consoles of the time, features and prices did not mix too well. In the end, the Lynx faded because of lack of third party support and not being budget friendly.

The legacy of the Lynx remains, a truly excellent group of games for this console which was ahead of its time.

The original Lynx console had a 'flip' switch, for left or right handed play, and a restart game function.

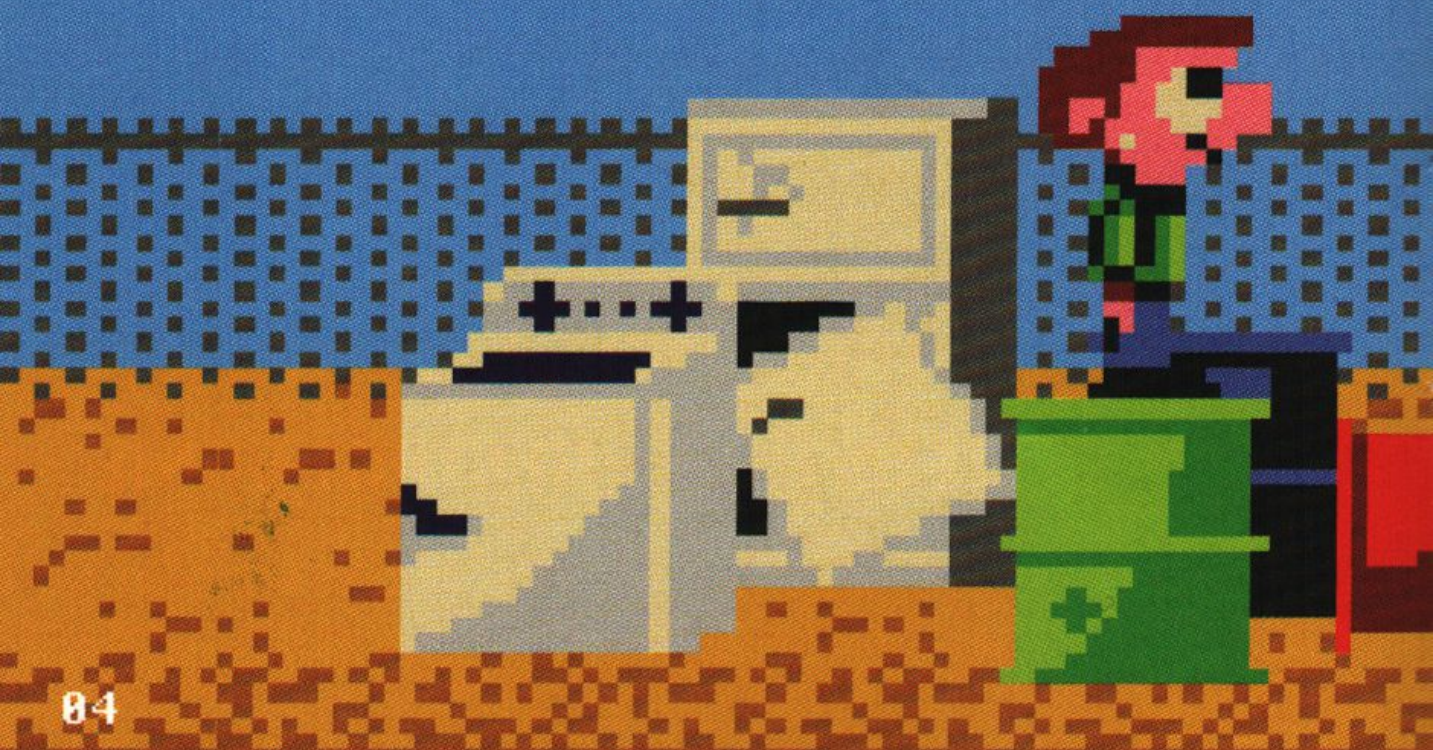


ABOUT THE GAME:

There are hidden items all over the place in this game, including shrinking power-ups, money bags, and level warps. Be sure to cover all the ground you can!



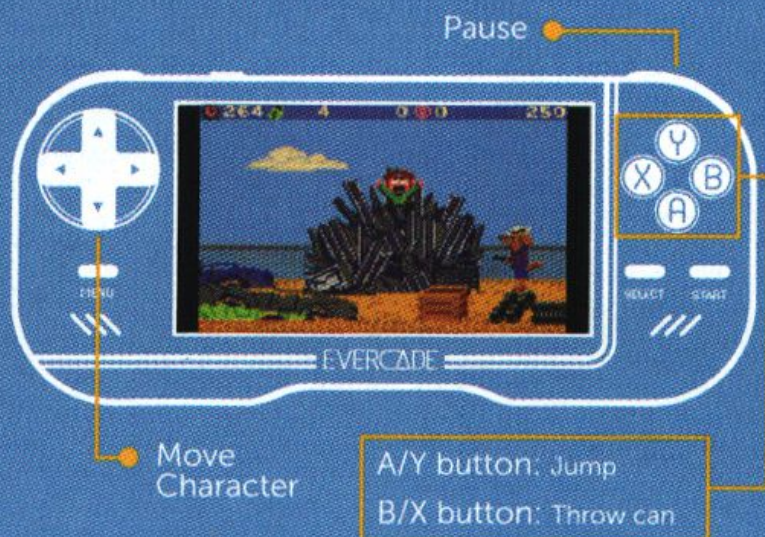
